- Note 1: Nationals of some countries which have a visa exemption arrangement with Japan are currently <u>strongly recommended to obtain a visa</u> prior to entering Japan. Strict landing examination will apply at passport control in Japan for those nationals arriving without visas. These countries are: Peru (since 15th July 1995) and Colombia (since 1st February 2004).
- Note 2: Nationals of Turkey, Lesotho and Barbados with NON-MACHINE READABLE PASSPORTS (NON-MRP) are strongly recommended to obtain a visa before entering Japan.
- Note 3: Visas are not required for Hong Kong SAR passport holders and BNO passports holders (Hong Kong permanent identity card holders).
- Note 4: Visas are not required for Macau SAR passport holders.
- Note 5: Visas are not required for Taiwan passport holders with a personal ID number shown in the respective passport.
- Note 6: Journalists who have US passports <u>must obtain a visa</u> to travel to Japan on business, regardless of the intended length of stay.
- Note 7: Visas are not required for Serbian IC passport holders only.
- Note 8: Visas are not required for Thai IC passport holders only.
- Note 9: Nationals of Malaysia with NON-ICAO standards IC passport (Please refer to this link) are strongly recommended to obtain a visa before entering Japan.
